Application Q&A

Are the courses conducted in Chinese?

English is the primary instructional language for all three programs. Depending on student demand, each school, nevertheless, may hire teaching assistants to help with teaching and course counseling. The Industry-Academia Collaboration Program for international students will offer Chinese lessons.

Types of internships? Work visa?

Schools will arrange internships for students at collaborating industries on the basis of their expertise. Only a student visa is required. Offcampus internships are considered as part of the course curriculum instead of work. It is thus not necessary to apply for a work visa.

Tuition, fees, and scholarships?

Universities may offer scholarships, stipends, or waiver of (part or all of) tuition and fees. Please consult the admission office of each university.
